**MOTION OF THE DIVISION OF RATEPAYER ADVOCATES
FOR LEAVE TO FILE CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL
UNDER SEAL; PROPOSED ORDER**

Pursuant to Rules 11.1 and 11.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (“DRA”) respectfully moves the Commission for leave to file under seal a version of DRA’S Brief on the IOUS’ Long-Term Procurement Plans for Bundled Customers containing confidential information.

The section of DRA’s brief on PG&E’s nuclear fuel procurement plan discusses information designated as confidential by PG&E in its Bundled Procurement Plan and supporting testimony. Confidential versions of both of these documents have been admitted into the record of this proceeding pursuant to a Protective Order. Accordingly, the Assigned Administrative Law Judge has already ruled that it is appropriate to keep this information confidential. Discussion of the confidential information is redacted in the Public Version of DRA’s brief.
