In compliance with California Public Utilities Code section 454.9 and California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) decisions, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) has filed a Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account (CEMA) application. The application filing requests changes in SCE's electric rates due to the incremental support costs associated with tree removal activities in 2007 and 2008 due to bark beetle infestation. The Application requests a one-time increase in SCE's revenue requirement of \$16.618 million, or 0.14 percent, which, if approved by the CPUC, will become effective in 2010.

Over 13-15 million trees, weakened by years of drought in the mountainous communities of Southern California are dead, dying or diseased due to a widespread bark beetle infestation. Removal of these dead, dying, and diseased trees began in 2003 and continued throughout 2007-2008 in SCE's service territory in affected areas of San Bernardino, Riverside, and Los Angeles counties. State of Emergency Proclamations were issued by the Governor in all of these counties. In accordance with CPUC Resolution E-3824, SCE is requesting compensation through its Bark Beetle CEMA for tree removal and incremental support costs related to the bark beetle infestation during 2007 and 2008. These costs are not part of SCE's normal business and therefore are not funded through existing rates.

In the proceeding regarding SCE's Bark Beetle CEMA Application, the CPUC will determine the reasonableness of SCE incremental tree removal support costs in 2007 and 2008. Assuming that the CPUC finds SCE's CEMA costs reasonable, the estimated 2010 one-time revenue requirement increase associated with the 2007 and 2008 Bark Beetle CEMA will be approximately \$16.618 million.

The proposed percentage increase in SCE's total revenue is 0.14 percent. Any revenue change resulting from this Application will be consolidated with revenue changes from other SCE applications. The following table shows an estimate of proposed revenues and rate changes by customer group:

THE CPUC WELCOMES YOUR PARTICIPATION AND COMMENTS

The CPUC may hold evidentiary hearings whereby formal parties of record provide testimony and are subject to cross-examination before a CPUC Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). These hearings are open to the public, but only those who are formal parties of record may participate. The CPUC has its own court reporters who will record the comments of those formal parties of record participating in the evidentiary hearings. After considering all proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process, the assigned ALJ will issue a proposed decision. When the CPUC issues a final decision on the application, it may adopt, amend, or modify all or part of the ALJ's proposed decision as written. The CPUC's decision may be different than SCE's request.

The Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) is an independent arm of the CPUC, created by the Legislature to represent the interests of all utility customers throughout the state to obtain the lowest possible rates for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels. DRA has a multi-disciplinary staff with expertise in economics, finance, accounting, and engineering.





In compliance with California Public Utilities Code section 454.9 and California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) decisions, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) has filed a Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account (CEMA) application. The application filing requests changes in SCE's electric rates due to the incremental support costs associated with tree removal activities in 2007 and 2008 due to bark beetle infestation. The Application requests a one-time increase in SCE's revenue requirement of \$16.618 million, or 0.14 percent, which, if approved by the CPUC, will become effective in 2010.

Over 13-15 million trees, weakened by years of drought in the mountainous communities of Southern California are dead, dying or diseased due to a widespread bark beetle infestation. Removal of these dead, dying, and diseased trees began in 2003 and continued throughout 2007-2008 in SCE's service territory in affected areas of San Bernardino, Riverside, and Los Angeles counties. State of Emergency Proclamations were issued by the Governor in all of these counties. In accordance with CPUC Resolution E-3824, SCE is requesting compensation through its Bark Beetle CEMA for tree removal and incremental support costs related to the bark beetle infestation during 2007 and 2008. These costs are not part of SCE's normal business and therefore are not funded through existing rates.

In the proceeding regarding SCE's Bark Beetle CEMA Application, the CPUC will determine the reasonableness of SCE incremental tree removal support costs in 2007 and 2008. Assuming that the CPUC finds SCE's CEMA costs reasonable, the estimated 2010 one-time revenue requirement increase associated with the 2007 and 2008 Bark Beetle CEMA will be approximately \$16.618 million.

The proposed percentage increase in SCE's total revenue is 0.14 percent. Any revenue change resulting from this Application will be consolidated with revenue changes from other SCE applications. The following table shows an estimate of proposed revenues and rate changes by customer group:
