NOTICE OF RIM ROCK TAX EQUITY
INVESTMENT RECOVERY
APPLICATION NO. A.10-07-017**

On July 15, 2010, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E®) filed a request with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) for approval to make an equity investment in the NaturEner Montana Wind Energy 3 (Rim Rock) project equal to the lesser of \$600 million or eighty percent (80%) of the total cost of the project. This investment will reduce the financing costs of the Rim Rock project, which in turn will produce more economic contract terms for ratepayers under the existing Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between NaturEner and SDG&E for 309 MW of renewable wind generation. In addition, SDG&E's investment will enhance the viability of the project which is expected to provide a significant quantity of renewable energy to SDG&E's portfolio. The application seeks approval of the revenue requirement associated with the equity investment that would take effect at the time the Rim Rock project is put into commercial operation, which is anticipated to be late 2012. The structure of the tax equity investment and the ratebase mechanism to recover the investment are detailed in SDG&E's application.

Illustrative Changes in Class Average
Electric Rates Due to Proposed Rim Rock
Tax Equity Investment**

Although SDG&E anticipates that rates will increase in some years due to SDG&E's equity investment in the Rim Rock project, the investment is forecasted to be rate neutral when factoring the net present value costs and benefits over the life of the project. If the Commission approves SDG&E's request, in 2013 a typical residential customer living in the inland climate zone and using 500

kWh per month will see a monthly bill increase in 2013 of 0.3%, or \$0.24. A typical monthly electric bill will increase from \$78.07 to \$78.31. The percentages shown do not necessarily reflect the changes that you may see in your bill. The impact on each customer and customer class could vary depending on the CPUC's final decision. Changes in individual bills will also depend on how much energy each customer uses. SDG&E estimates that the requested rate increase associated with the SDG&E's equity investment in the Rim Rock project during 2013, 2014 and 2015 would be allocated in a manner shown in the table below

* Pursuant to California Assembly Bill 1X, electric rates for residential usage up to 130% of baseline allowances will not exceed rate levels in effect February 1, 2001, with the exceptions that rates for usage up to 130% of baseline shall be increased 3% to 5% each year pursuant to California Senate Bill 695, and to recover costs associated with the California Solar Initiative.

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CPUC PROCESS

The CPUC may hold Evidentiary Hearings (EHs) whereby parties of record provide testimony and are subject to cross-examination before a CPUC Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). These hearings are open to the public, but only those who are formal parties of record can participate. The CPUC has its own court reporters who will record the comments of those formal parties of record participating in the EHs. The Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) is an independent arm of the CPUC, created by the Legislature to represent the interests of all utility customers throughout the state to obtain the lowest possible rates for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels. DRA has a multi-disciplinary staff with expertise in economics, finance, accounting and engineering. After considering all proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process, the assigned ALJ will issue a proposed draft decision. When the CPUC issues a final decision on the application, it may adopt, amend or modify all or part of the ALJ's proposed decision as written. The CPUC's decision may be different than SDG&E's formal request.


I, Mary Ann Tilos, am a citizen of the United States residing in San Diego County, California, and am over the age of 18.

I am now, and at all times referred to below, have been employed by the San Diego Gas & Electric Company as Creative Services & Branding Advisor in San Diego, California.


