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THE ADEQUACY OF NATURAL GAS SUPPLY FOR INFRASTRUCTURE**

On October 25, 2010, the Third Amended Scoping Memo and Ruling of Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Addressing Motion for Reconsideration and Related Requests (Third Amended Scoping Memo) was issued, granting, in part, the July 27, 2010 Motion for Reconsideration, submitted by the Avondale Glen Elder Neighborhood Association (AGENA), identifying the scope of issues that were to be considered in supplemental hearings, and scheduling supplemental hearings. Issues to be considered in supplemental hearings were limited to “need for the Proposed Project” within the context of “overriding considerations” as described in Public Utilities Code section 1002. (Third Amended Scoping Memo, pp. 11-12.) Supplemental evidentiary hearings on “need for the Proposed Project” were held on January 10 and 11, 2011.

Both verbally during a telephonic hearing on January 11, 2011 and in an electronic mail message on January 12, 2011 that references the transcript from the January 11,

2011 hearing, ALJ Smith directed AGENA to submit additional information, described below, not later than January 18, 2011 and indicated that parties would have an opportunity to comment on the accuracy and completeness of the additional information, but not on the substance of the information, not later than January 21, 2011. (See TR 497:18 – 500:15.) Specifically, ALJ Smith directed AGENA “to submit a document identifying any appearances of AGENA before the [Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD)] in connection with the SMUD contract with [Sacramento Natural Gas Storage, LLC (SNGS)] for storage services.” (TR 497:27 – 498:3.) ALJ Smith continued: “And for each appearance AGENA should list the date and a brief description of AGENA's comments or presentation.” (TR 498:3 – 498:6.)

Additionally, ALJ Smith requested that, in this document, AGENA “list any appearances of AGENA before the California Energy Commission in connection with the SMUD contract with SNGS for storage services or in relation to any of the topics addressed in AGENA's supplemental testimony concerning the adequacy of natural gas supply for infrastructure.” (TR 498:7 – 498:14.) ALJ Smith continued: “For each appearance AGENA should list the date and a brief description of AGENA’s comments or presentation.” (TR 498:15 – 498:17.)

AGENA understands the aforementioned request for information to encompass only AGENA’s appearances at public meetings of the SMUD Board and/or SMUD Board Committees. Therefore, AGENA provides the following information.

Appearances Before the Sacramento Municipal Utility District

AGENA has made the following public appearances before the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) Board and/or SMUD Board Committees in connection with the SMUD contract with SNGS for storage services (Contract). AGENA lists below the date of each appearance at a public SMUD Board or SMUD Board Committee meeting and a brief description of AGENA's corresponding comments

or presentation. For each appearance, AGENA commented verbally to the SMUD Board in the customary manner for submission of public comments, for example, limited to three minutes, and not in the manner of an evidentiary hearing.

September 16, 2008 SMUD Board Policy Committee Meeting: AGENA's verbal comments to the SMUD Board Policy Committee encouraged the SMUD Board Policy Committee to vote against extending the milestone periods for so-called "SMUD off-ramps" contained in the Contract and to reschedule its meeting to evening hours so that members of AGENA and other members of the community could more readily attend.

October 2, 2008 SMUD Regular Board Meeting: AGENA's verbal comments to the SMUD Board encouraged the SMUD Board to vote to withdraw from the Contract, the milestone periods contained therein having then expired, or, alternatively, to vote against extending the milestone periods contained in the Contract.

AGENA also provided written comments to the SMUD Board, which:

(1) discussed SMUD's potential liability from operation of the SNGS Project; (2) urged the SMUD Board to vote against renewing the Contract or, alternatively, to postpone voting on renewal of the Contract until after all permit review processes had been completed for the Proposed SNGS Project, including the environmental review to be conducted by the CPUC, and all entitlements had been acquired by SNGS; and (3) urged the SMUD Board to consider amending the Contract to further protect the community, including enhancing the insurance coverage requirement to cover the then-asserted significant risks of harm to the community from the Proposed SNGS Project.

July 13, 2010 SMUD Board Finance Committee Meeting: AGENA's verbal comments to the SMUD Board Finance Committee were on an off-agenda item and, therefore, precluded the SMUD Board Finance Committee from acting on AGENA's comments at that meeting. AGENA's verbal comments to the SMUD Board Finance Committee directed the SMUD Board Finance Committee's attention to the conclusions

contained in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) about the significant and unavoidable environmental impacts of the Proposed SNGS Project, registered AGENA's opposition to the Proposed SNGS Project on the basis that the FEIR had determined that the Proposed SNGS Project posed a significant risk to the community, and encouraged the SMUD Board to stand up for the safety of the community. Other community members registered their opposition to the Proposed SNGS Project and urged the SMUD Board to adopt a similar position.

Appearances Before the California Energy Commission


