AT&T California and Verizon move for leave to file late reply comments, a copy of which is lodged concurrently herewith, in response to the March 1, 2012 “Smart Grid Workshop Report.”

AT&T California participated in the workshop on January 31, 2012 during a discussion on whether the Commission should set a demarcation point. However, neither AT&T nor Verizon were served with a copy of the Workshop Report because neither were parties to this proceeding. The Workshop Report set out a briefing schedule and solicited comments from participants on, among other things, whether the Commission should set a demarcation point.

Soon after they become aware of the Workshop Report, AT&T promptly moved for party status and Verizon followed suit. By then, the briefing schedule set out in the Workshop Report had passed. Had AT&T and Verizon been served with the Workshop Report earlier, they would have filed comments timely.

The Commission and Staff would benefit from AT&T and Verizon’s input on the demarcation issue. Both companies have an interest in the Smart Grid market, and have participated in the R.08-12-009 proceeding and filed comments there.
