(U 39-E) NOTICE OF WORKSHOPS REGARDING INVESTMENT PLANS FOR
ELECTRIC PROGRAM INVESTMENT CHARGE PROGRAM**

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In Ordering Paragraph 15 of Decision 12-05-037, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) ordered the administrators of the Electric Program Investment Charge (EPIC) program to consult with stakeholders at least twice per year regarding their investment plans. The Commission further ordered the administrators to provide notice of the consultations to the parties on the service list for the above-captioned rulemaking.

Southern California Edison Company (SCE), San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E), Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E), and the California Energy Commission (CEC) will administer the EPIC program, under the oversight of the Commission. SCE, SDG&E, and PG&E hereby provide notice of workshops for the purpose of consulting with stakeholders regarding their investment plans.¹ The workshops will seek stakeholder input at the

¹ The CEC intends to also hold workshop(s) and will seek stakeholder input on the 80% of EPIC funding to be administered by the CEC. The CEC workshop(s) will address the Applied Research, Technology Demonstration and Deployment, and Market Facilitation program areas as designated by the Commission.

programmatic level on the 20% of EPIC funding designated by the Commission to be administered by the utilities and will primarily address utility electricity grid-related technology demonstration and deployment.

PG&E will hold a workshop in Northern California on August 16, 2012. SCE and SDG&E will hold a joint workshop in Southern California on August 17, 2012. Information on each workshop's location and how to participate are as follows:
