Pursuant to Rule 2.6 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), Marin Energy Authority (“MEA”) respectfully submits this response to the Motion for Consideration of the San Francisco Bay Area Regional Energy Network (“BayREN”), filed on August 2, 2012.

MEA is the California Community Choice Aggregator (“CCA”) serving customers in Marin County, and will soon begin serving customers in the City of Richmond. MEA is also taking steps to administer Energy Efficiency (“EE”) programs within its service territory. Pursuant to the instructions put forth in Administrative Law Judge’s Ruling Regarding Procedures for Local Government Regional Energy Network Submissions for 2013-2014 and for Community Choice Aggregators to Administer Energy Efficiency Programs (“Ruling”) issued on June 20, 2012 by ALJ Julie A. Fitch within Rulemaking R.09-11-014, MEA is applying to administer EE funds for the 2013-2014 program cycle concurrently with local government’s applications to form Regional Energy Networks (“RENS”). In this Ruling, it is evident that all proposals submitted by parties will be evaluated on programmatic “coordination, overlap, or gap issues” with other parties’ proposals. (Ruling at 13.)
