**THIRD AMENDMENT TO SCOPING MEMO AND RULING OF
THE ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE**

The amendment to scoping memo ruling dated December 17, 2010 projected that a final decision would be adopted by the Commission by June 17, 2012. However, the recent reports from the parties, confirmed by the Commission's Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD), is that the parties and CPSD require just a few more weeks to wrap up their productive and collaborative discussion toward arriving at a comprehensive and coherent set of proposed General Order provisions responsive to this rulemaking.

To allow for necessary time for the parties to finalize their discussion, and to allow for time to review the parties' anticipated proposed General Order and its provisions as well as staff recommendations relating thereto, we anticipate a minor schedule augmentation. We expect this should take no more than three additional months beyond June 17, 2012 (the original projected date for adoption of the final decision), anticipating various scheduling contingencies.
