**SECOND AMENDMENT TO SCOPING MEMO AND RULING OF  
THE ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE**

The amendment to scoping memo ruling dated October 22, 2010 projected that a final decision could be adopted by the Commission by June 30, 2012.

The final briefs have been filed as of April 2012, and the matter is under consideration before the Commission. To allow for necessary time for the Commission's review of the record and meaningful deliberation of the issues, we anticipate a minor schedule augmentation. We expect this should take no more than three additional months beyond June 30, 2012 (the original projected date for adoption of the final decision), anticipating various scheduling contingencies.
