**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SCHEDULING
TECHNICAL WORKSHOP ON ENERGY EFFICIENCY CALCULATIONS**

This ruling serves notice that a technical workshop is hereby scheduled for Wednesday, September 16, 2009, starting at 9:00 a.m. The first topic to be addressed during the workshop will be a question-and-answer session regarding the energy efficiency program results in the Energy Division's Draft Energy Efficiency 2006-2008 Verification Report covering energy efficiency activities during the 2006-2008 period. A Draft Commission Resolution was circulated on August 6, 2009 for adoption of the Energy Division EM&V Report, and parties have provided written comments on the Report.

The workshop scheduled for September 16, 2009, will provide all stakeholders the opportunity to discuss the draft Verification Report in person, pursuant to procedures set forth in Decision (D.) 07-09-043, Attachment 7. Workshop participants will be provided the opportunity to ask questions and seek clarification concerning the calculations and methodologies underlying the results set forth in the Draft Verification Report.

The second topic of the workshop will be a question-and-answer session regarding the Energy Division analysis of the incentive payments calculated based upon the assumptions in the Proposed Settlement submitted in this

proceeding for the 2006-2008 program period. The Energy Division analysis of the Proposed Settlement uses the "Verification Report Template" calculation tool that has been previously used to develop the Interim Verification Reports. The Energy Division has run two scenarios that apply the parameters and assumptions set forth in the Proposed Settlement. Both of the scenarios calculated by the Energy Division incorporate the adjustments made in the Proposed Settlement to the following parameters: Net-to-Gross Ratio assumptions, Expected Useful Life values, treatment of interactive effects, CFL residential/non-residential split, and the CFL in-service rate. These two scenarios differ only in that Scenario 1 makes no change to the installation counts reported by the utilities, while Scenario 2 applies Energy Division's verified installation rate.

In D.09-05-037 (Conclusion of Law No. 2), the Commission concluded that cumulative savings should be counted for the period 2006-2011, excluding 2004-2005 data. Certain parties have thus argued that 2004-2005 data should be excluded in computing cumulative savings used for incentive awards for 2006-2008. In order to show the cumulative effects of using the 2004-2005 data, Energy Division ran calculations of incentive payments under Scenarios 1 and 2 assuming (a) 2004-2005 goals and savings are included and (b) 2004-2005 goals and savings are excluded in calculating the 2006-2008 incentive awards.

In preparation for the September 16th workshop, parties should review the Energy Division summary results referenced above. Parties should come to the

workshop prepared with any questions or points of clarification regarding the Energy Division analysis in both the Verification Report and the Scenario 1 and 2 calculations relating the effects of the Proposed Settlement for 2006-2008.

At the conclusion of the workshop, there will be a discussion of the schedule for any supplemental comments regarding the Verification Report for purposes of the Draft Resolution and also regarding the Energy Division scenarios regarding the incentive payments calculated under the Proposed Settlement for the 2006-2008 period for purposes of the Commission's consideration in this rulemaking proceeding.

IT IS RULED that:

1. A technical workshop is hereby scheduled for Wednesday, September 16, 2009, starting at 9:00 a.m., at the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.
2. The workshop will cover the topics set forth above, and will be moderated by the Commission's Energy Division.
3. In preparation for the workshop, parties should access and review the Energy Division analysis, available online after 5:00 p.m. on September 3, 2009, at the web site referenced above. Parties should come to the workshop prepared with any questions or points of clarification.
