**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
REQUIRING HIDDEN HILLS SUBUNIT RATEPAYERS ASSOCIATION
TO FILE A RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR INFORMATION REGARDING ITS
INTERVENOR COMPENSATION CLAIM WITHIN 10 DAYS**

On September 15, 2009, Hidden Hills Subunit Ratepayers Association (Hidden Hills) filed a request for Intervenor Compensation in Application (A.) A.08-01-024 and A.08-01-027.

Upon review of the request I find that the Commission needs additional information, as outlined in Attachment A, in order to process this request. In this

request, Hidden Hills has provided almost exactly the same invoices from Noland, Hamerly, Etienne and Hoss, as those provided in support of its request for compensation in A.07-12-010. From the information provided, it is not obvious which line items may be attributable to the separate requests.

Hidden Hills has also failed to provide itemization of direct expenses, as required by Rule 17.4.

Hidden Hills shall file a document entitled "Response to the Inquiries of the ALJ" within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Hidden Hills shall respond to all requests in Attachment A to this ruling by filing its response as a document entitled "Response to the Inquiries of the ALJ" within 10 days of the date of this ruling. In addition to standard requirements associated with filing and service, one hard copy shall be served on Administrative Law Judge Seaneen M. Wilson.
2. Hidden Hills shall provide a CD to ALJ Wilson of all Microsoft Excel spreadsheets requested in Attachment A.

 - a. Many Line Items of NHEH Statements (attached to request) are not clear as to whether they are attributable to a CPUC, MPWMD, or Other proceeding. Clarify these line items.
5. Hours Attributable to Line Item,
6. Cost of Line Item, and
7. State whether line item overlaps with work performed in A.07-12-010, and if so, state how much of Line Item time is attributable to work performed in A.07-12-010 and how much Line Item time is attributable to work performed in A.08-01-024/027.

B. Provide a detailed summary (Microsoft Excel Spreadsheet) of work billed by Glen Stransky and Russ Hatch, for which Hidden Hills is requesting intervenor compensation in A.08-01-024/027 by:

1. Person,
2. Activity (Before the CPUC, Before the MPWMD, Other),
3. Date work performed,
4. Line Item Text (Description of Work Performed),
5. Hours Attributable to Line Item,
6. Cost of Line Item, and
7. State whether line item overlaps with work performed in A.07-12-010, and if so, state how much Line Item time is attributable to work performed in A.07-12-010 and how much Line Item time is attributable to work performed in A.08-01-024/027.

C. For all Hotel, Meals, Mileage, Parking, Photocopying, and WestLaw research, for which Hidden Hills is requesting intervenor compensation in

A.08-01-024/027, provide:

1. Copy of Supporting Documentation.
2. Provide detailed summary (Microsoft Excel Spreadsheet) of the following, by type of expense (Hotel Meals, Mileage, Parking, and Photocopying:
 - a. Person who incurred expense.
 - b. Dates expense incurred.
 - c. Specific reason Hidden Hills requests reimbursement for expense (for example, attendance at a hearing on a particular date).
 - d. Rate charged (for example, what rates were used for Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner; per page copy charge).
 - e. State whether line item charge overlaps with work performed in A.07-12-010, and if so, state how much of charge is attributable to work performed in A.07-12-010 and how much of charge is attributable to work performed in A.08-01-024/027.
