**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
SETTING FURTHER REVISED SCHEDULE**

On October 23, 2009, the Commission's Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD) informed the assigned Administrative Law Judge Kim of the need for additional time to submit the Staff Report and Recommendation due to some unexpected delays in the expert consultant's report.
