**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING EXTENDING TIME  
FOR COMMENTS AND REPLY COMMENTS**

The Revised Proposed Decision Authorizing Use of Renewable Energy Credits for Compliance with the California Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPD) was mailed for comment on December 23, 2009. In accordance with Rule 14.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, comments would be due on January 12, 2010 and reply comments would be due on January 18, 2010.<sup>1</sup>

The RPD will appear on the Commission's agenda no earlier than the Commission meeting of February 4, 2010. There are thus more than 30 days between the mailing date and the Commission's earliest consideration of the RPD. In view of the intervening holiday period, the time for comments and reply comments can and should be extended.

1. Comments on the Revised Proposed Decision Authorizing Use of Renewable Energy Credits for Compliance with the California Renewables Portfolio Standard may be filed and served not later than January 19, 2010.
2. Reply comments on the Revised Proposed Decision Authorizing Use of Renewable Energy Credits for Compliance with the California Renewables Portfolio Standard may be filed and served not later than January 25, 2010.
3. All comments and reply comments must be served on Administrative Law Judge Simon by electronic mail and paper copy.
