**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
ON MOTIONS FOR CONFIDENTIALITY**

This ruling addresses several outstanding motions for confidential treatment of filings in the above-captioned proceeding.

On March 8, March 11, and March 12, 2010, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) filed motions for leave to file ex parte notices with confidential attachments under seal. DRA states that its ex parte notices of meetings with Commissioner Peevey and advisors to other Commissioners contain attachments with information identified by Pacific Gas and Electric Company as confidential and therefore not subject to public disclosure.
