Parties and other interested stakeholders to R.08-08-009:

On May 6, 2010, President Michael Peevey will hold an All-Party meeting in R.08-08-009 from 1:30 to 3:00 PM at the Commission's main offices in San Francisco. The purpose of the All-Party meeting is to discuss the utilities' respective interpretation and enforcement of the curtailment provisions of RPS contracts as applied to existing contracts, as well as prospectively, for contracts that have not yet been submitted to the Commission pursuant to the utilities' 2010 RPS procurement plans.

In order to develop the agenda for the All-Party meeting, parties and other interested stakeholders should respond to this notice no later than Friday, April 30, 2010, indicating their interest in participating at the All-Party meeting, and the name of the individual that will be speaking on their organization's behalf. Responses to this notice will be used to allocate time to those that wish to have a specific window allocated to them to make a statement regarding this issue. If a party or other stakeholder wishes only to attend or be available to participate on an ad hoc basis, they need not respond to this notice. They may still attend, but will not be allocated a specific time slot to express their views. The respondent utilities, Pacific Gas and Electric, Southern California Edison, and San Diego Gas and Electric, should participate to explain past and current curtailment practices and proposals and will be given time to present accordingly.

Respondents should come to the meeting prepared to discuss their positions on the curtailment issue as well as to discuss the implications of the utilities' respective curtailment provisions and interpretation thereof on project financing and viability. We encourage parties and other stakeholders with a common perspective on this issue to work together to consolidate their statements to the extent practicable.
