**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
GRANTING GPI MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE COMMENTS  
ON THE MARCH 2010 IOU PRS COMPLIANCE REPORTS**

Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), on April 12, 2010, the Green Power Institute (GPI) moved for leave to file comments on the March 2010 Investor-Owned Utility (IOU) Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) compliance reports. In support, GPI says it is in the best interest of the conduct of this proceeding for the Commission to allow GPI to formally file comments on the March 2010 IOU RPS compliance reports. According to GPI, this will place the utilities' procurement data into the record and bring GPI's perspective on that data to the attention of the Commission, utilities and parties. GPI states that this information is sufficiently important and compelling to justify it being formally placed in the record of this proceeding.

No responses have been filed. (Rule 11.1(e).) GPI's unopposed motion should be granted.
