**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
POSTPONING SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE
AND PROVIDING FOR REPLY COMMENTS**

By ruling dated April 8, 2010, a schedule was established for addressing the Risk/Reward Incentive Mechanism (RRIM) earnings true up for 2006-2008. That ruling scheduled the date of May 28, 2010 for a settlement conference to address the 2006-2008 true up of earnings. That settlement conference is hereby postponed to a later date to be set by a subsequent ruling. The value of the settlement conference will be enhanced if parties first have the opportunity to submit written responses to the opening comments filed on May 18, 2010, regarding the RRIM true up scenario runs. The April 8, 2010 ruling called for "comments or testimony on disputed issues" to be due on June 11, 2010. Parties shall file reply comments on June 11, 2010, responding to positions and arguments raised by opposing parties in the opening comments on RRIM scenario runs filed. The schedule and process for subsequent settlement discussions will be addressed in a separate ruling.

IT IS RULED that:

1. The settlement conference regarding the 2006-2008 true up of Risk/Reward Incentive Mechanism earnings, previously scheduled for May 28, 2010, is hereby postponed until a later date to be set by a subsequent ruling.

2. Parties shall file reply comments on June 11, 2010, responding to the opening comments filed on May 18, 2010, regarding the scenario runs for the 2006-2008 true up.
