**RULING REGARDING COMMENTS ON IMPACT OF DECISION 10-12-050
ON PETITION FOR MODIFICATION FILED BY CALIFORNIANS
FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY**

1. Summary

In Decision (D.) 09-10-017, the Commission adopted an all-party Settlement Agreement and approved the first long-term power purchase agreement to procure 184 megawatts (MW) of new generation resources resulting from Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) 2008 Long-Term Request for Offers. On October 9, 2010, CALifornians for Renewable Energy (CARE) filed a petition for modification, stating that circumstances had changed and the settlement was no longer valid. By this ruling, I direct parties to comment on the impact of D.10-12-050 on CARE's petition for modification.

2. Background

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed Application 09-04-001 on April 1, 2009, seeking an expedited order by November 2009 in order to ensure that the Mariposa Energy Center would be on line by 2012. Protests were timely filed by CARE and by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA). PG&E properly noticed and convened a settlement conference on August 28, 2009.

PG&E, DRA, CARE, The Utility Reform Network (TURN), and California Unions for Reliable Energy (CURE) filed a motion for approval of a proposed all-party Settlement Agreement on September 3, 2009. The Settlement Agreement was uncontested and no evidentiary hearings were convened. D.09-10-017 approved the Settlement Agreement without modification and included the following key provisions:

- a. The total need to be procured from the 2008 Long-Term Request for Offers will be limited to 1,512 MW under peak July conditions, inclusive of the 184 MW included in the Mariposa Power Purchase Agreement (PPA).
- b. The balance of PG&E's need authorization (1,328 MW) will be met, but not exceeded, by one application for approval of additional agreements resulting from PG&E's 2008 Long-Term Request for Offers.
- c. PG&E will meet and confer with the parties in the event that Mariposa Energy requests a PPA that seeks to increase the prices of the Mariposa Power Purchase Agreement for capacity, fixed operations and maintenance rate, and variable operations and maintenance costs rate, as set forth in PG&E's confidential testimony. In the event of such an amendment, the prices will not exceed those delineated in the testimony unless the parties concur with the amendment to these prices or PG&E has conducted a Request for Offers, evaluated market alternatives, and found the new prices proposed for the amendment to be competitive with the results of its Request for Offers. The parties reserve the right to oppose any such amendment. PG&E will require as a condition for any amendment that Mariposa Energy reimburse PG&E for any Commission-awarded intervenor compensation, to the extent that there is intervenor participation in a Commission proceeding regarding the reasonableness of any amendment.
- d. PG&E shall recover the costs of all payments made pursuant to the Mariposa PPA through the Energy

Resources Recovery Account. PG&E recover any stranded costs associated with the Mariposa Power Purchase Agreement from departing load throughout the term of the Power Purchase Agreement as non-bypassable charges consistent with D.04-12-048 and D.08-09-012.

D.09-10-017 also provided that to the extent that PG&E requires reimbursement from Mariposa Energy, LLC for any intervenor compensation awarded for proceedings regarding the reasonableness of amendments to the Mariposa PPA, outlined in Ordering Paragraph 1.c., any such reimbursed awards shall not be recovered from ratepayers.

3. CARE's Petition for Modification

CARE states that PG&E has violated the settlement agreement approved in D.09-10-017, because PG&E has signed contracts to procure a total of 1,743 MW in new capacity from the 2008 long-term request for offer (LTRFO) process. CARE explains that PG&E filed Applications (A.) 09-10-022 and 09-10-034, seeking approval of 254 MW in upgraded PPAs and also filed A.09-09-021, in which PG&E sought approval of 1,305 MW from the Marsh Landing and Oakley PPAs. CARE therefore contends that PG&E knowingly violated D.09-10-017 and asks that the settlement be rejected and that PG&E be sanctioned.

4. Response to CARE's Petition

PG&E and DRA timely filed and served responses to CARE's petition. PG&E explains that it filed A.09-09-021, in which it requested approval of four PPAs from the 2008 LTRFO. The total new general resource MW proposed in A.09-09-021 was 1,305 MW. At about the same time, PG&E filed A.09-10-022, requesting approval of the TWF transaction and the Los Esteros Critical Energy Facility. Both of these transactions included new PPAs for upgrades to the TWF Tracy Facility and for upgrades to the Los Esteros Critical Energy Facility. PG&E maintains that the upgrade PPAs at issue in A.09-10-022 and A.09-10-034 were

not winning offers in the 2008 LTRFO process, but instead were proposed by PG&E as part of an overall approach to novation of contracts with the Department of Water Resources.

PG&E states that CARE raised the Mariposa Settlement in protests to both A.09-09-021 and A.09-10-022 (subsequently consolidated with A.09-10-034), but did not seek to reopen the Mariposa Settlement approved in D.09-10-017. PG&E contends that the petition for modification is untimely, is not based on new facts, and is prejudicial to both the Mariposa Energy Project and PG&E, since the developer has proceeded with the Mariposa Project. Moreover, PG&E maintains that it complied with the Mariposa Settlement, because it filed a single application requesting approval of 1,305 MW of new generation related to the 2008 LTRFO process and that the 254 MW at issue in the GWF Tracy and Los Esteros Critical Energy Facility were not offered to meet the need identified in D.07-12-052, the Long-Term Procurement Plan decision.

DRA concurs with CARE and states that PG&E has violated Condition B of the Mariposa Settlement Agreement, because PG&E has requested approval of a total of 1,743 MW in new generation rather than the 1,512 MW approved in D.09-10-017. However, DRA explains that CARE's request for sanctions is premature, since, at that time, the Commission had approved 1,157 MW in new generation related to the 2008 LTRFO process. However, DRA explains that PG&E filed a petition to modify D.10-07-045 and now requests approval of the Oakley Project. If this 586 MW PPA is approved, PG&E will exceed the authorized capacity of 1,512 MW by 231 MW and will thereby breach the Mariposa Settlement Agreement. If the Commission approves this petition for modification, DRA recommends that sanctions be imposed on PG&E for

violating the Mariposa Settlement Agreement, and such sanctions could include the suspension of the Mariposa PPA.

5. Comments on Impact of D.10-12-050

D.10-07-042 rejected the PPAs for the GWF Tracy and the Los Esteros Critical Energy Facility Upgrades and explained that these PPAs did not comply with the 1,512 MW limit adopted in the Mariposa Settlement and that the MW attributable to these facilities should be counted toward the MW specified in that settlement. D.10-07-042 also determined that PG&E could file a Tier 1 Advice Letter for approval of the Upgrade PPAs if either the Marsh Landing or Oakley Projects at issue in A.09-09-021 were rejected. The Commission clearly stated that the Upgrade PPA were to be counted toward the 2008 procurement for new capacity.

In D.10-07-045, issued in A.09-09-021, the Commission approved the 719 MW PPA for the Marsh Landing Project but rejected the 586 MW for PPA for Oakley Project. PG&E subsequently filed Advice Letter 3711-E for approval of the 254 MW Upgrades associated with GWF Tracy and Los Esteros. Thus, out of a total 1,743 MW requested by PG&E, the Commission has approved 1,157 MW in new generation procurement (184 MW approved in the Mariposa Settlement in D.09-10-017, 254 MW approved by Advice Letter 3711-E, and 719 MW approved in D.10-07-045).

On August 23, 2010, PG&E filed a petition for modification of D.10-07-045, requesting approval of the 586 MW PPA for the Oakley Project. The Commission approved this request by D.10-12-050, issued in A.09-09-021 on December 20, 2010. By this Ruling, I direct parties to this proceeding to comment on the impact of D.10-12-050 on CARE's petition for modification. Concurrent opening comments shall be filed and served by January 28, 2011, and reply

comments shall be filed and served by February 18, 2011. This Ruling shall also be served on the service list to A.09-09-021, but these proceedings are not consolidated.
