**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
LIFTING STAY AND REQUIRING STATUS REPORTS**

On May 17, 2010, the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) Ruling Staying Proceeding stayed this proceeding in light of Decision (D.) 10-05-018. That decision stayed D.10-03-021, which among other things authorized the use of tradable renewable energy credits for compliance with the California renewables portfolio standard. With the stay of D.10-03-021, the relief requested in this application could not be granted, so this proceeding was stayed.

In D.11-01-025, the Commission lifted the stay on D.10-03-021. The stay imposed in this proceeding should therefore be lifted.

The ALJ's Ruling on Status of Application (April 22, 2010) directed that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) seek approval of the contracts in this application by advice letter. It is not clear from the current record of this proceeding whether PG&E has done so. Because of the lapse of time since that ruling, and the intervening stay, the orderly administration of this proceeding would benefit from status reports by the parties. Parties may, but are not

required to, prepare a joint status report. Either a joint status report or separate status reports will meet the requirements of this ruling.

IT IS RULED that:

1. The stay on this proceeding imposed by the ALJ's Ruling Staying Proceeding is lifted, effective on the date of this ruling.
2. PG&E must, and other parties may, file and serve a status report of not more than 10 pages not later than February 4, 2011.
