**CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
AMENDING THE PROCEEDING CAPTION ON HER OWN MOTION**

This ruling amends the proceeding caption of Case (C.) 10-10-015, to reflect two oral rulings made by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Jessica T. Hecht during the February 9, 2011 prehearing conference (PHC) convened to hear a report on the status of this complaint and develop a schedule to resolve its issues. On December 3, 2010, Tessera Solar, LLC, (Tessera) the original complainant in this case, filed a written motion to amend C.10-10-015 to add Calico Solar, LLC (Calico) as a complainant, and at the PHC, Tessera sought leave to withdraw from the proceeding¹. ALJ Hecht granted these motions.

¹ When Tessera filed this complaint, Calico was its wholly-owned subsidiary and the developer of the project at issue in C.10-10-015. Tessera recently sold Calico.

In the interest of administrative efficiency, ALJ Hecht also granted Calico's motion to dismiss its companion complaint case², because to proceed with or consolidate it with this proceeding would be duplicative and unnecessary. Calico has indicated that it intends to amend the instant matter imminently to take note of events that occurred after the original complaint was filed. Before Calico amends C.10-10-015, the caption of this case should be revised to reflect the change in status.

Therefore, **IT IS RULED** that:

1. The caption in Case 10-10-015 is revised, as set forth above, and adopted here.
2. The entry for this proceeding shall be corrected in the Commission's Case Information System, and all future filings from this date shall include the amended caption.
