**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS**

**Discussion**

This case is one among several similar cases pending before the public utility commissions of California and other states. All of the pending cases present similar, if not identical, issues regarding the interpretation of interconnection agreements between the parties. The parties are engaged in discussions in an effort to settle the dispute giving rise to AT&T California's complaint in this matter and the similar complaints in the other jurisdictions on a global basis. On October 12, 2010, proceedings in this case were stayed until January 12, 2011 to enable the parties to continue their efforts to reach a global settlement.

The parties have agreed that a brief additional stay of this proceeding and similar proceedings in the other states will facilitate a multi-state settlement of the underlying disputes. In connection with the parties' settlement discussions, Sprint has provided certain additional data to AT&T California and its incumbent local exchange carrier affiliates which the parties require time to analyze.

**IT IS RULED** that this proceeding is stayed until May 15, 2011.
