**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ADMITTING PHASE 3  
EXHIBITS INTO THE RECORD**

This ruling admits into evidence the exhibits set forth below, as requested in the motion dated November 15, 2011, filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) in Application (A.) 10-03-014.

On November 10, 2011, PG&E filed an all-party settlement on Revised Customer Energy Statement (RCES) issues which all active parties in Phase 3 have signed concurrently with a motion for adoption of the settlement. Prior to reaching settlement, PG&E, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates, The Utility Reform Network, and the Center for Accessible Technology (C for AT) submitted testimony. The Greenlining Institute also signed the RCES settlement, but did not submit testimony.

PG&E filed a motion on November 15, 2011, requesting that exhibits for Phase 3 of this proceeding, regarding the RCES issues, be marked for identification and admitted into evidence. PG&E presents the following list of exhibits relating to RCES issues, including testimony from its own witness as

well as from that of DRA, TURN, and C for AT, marked for identification with exhibit numbers 167 through 173: These exhibit numbers continue the series of numbering assigned to exhibits admitted in the previous phase of this proceeding.

**IT IS RULED** that the motion of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, filed November 15, 2011, for the admission of Exhibits 167 through 172, as identified above, relating to the Phase 3 of this proceeding (addressing Revised Customer Energy Statement issues) is hereby granted. Exhibits 167 through 172 are hereby admitted into the evidentiary record.
