**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
DIRECTING SETTLING PARTIES TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

This ruling directs Golden State Water Company, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates, and The Utility Reform Network (collectively, Settling Parties) to submit additional information in connection with their June 21, 2012 joint motion for approval of proposed settlement (Proposed Settlement). Not later than July 23, 2012, the Settling Parties must file and serve additional information for each ratemaking area, as described below, to show the revenue requirement, rate base, and average residential rate changes that would result from the Proposed Settlement, if adopted.

For each ratemaking area, the Settling Parties must provide a table showing (1) adopted 2011 revenues; (2) proposed 2013 revenues; and (3) the Year 2013 dollar and percent change in revenues from adopted 2011 revenues. This table should be presented in a similar format as the table shown at 2 of the Application.

For each ratemaking area, the Settling Parties must provide a table showing (1) the proposed Year 2013 dollar and percent change in revenues from 2013 estimated revenues at current rates; and (2) dollar and percent change in revenues for 2014 and 2015 from the prior year at proposed rates. This table should be presented in a similar format and show comparable information as the table shown at 2 - 3 of the Application.

For each ratemaking area, the Settling Parties must provide tables comparing the proposed 2013 test year with the Year 2011 revenue requirement, rate base, rate base change in dollars and percent, operating expenses, operating expense change in dollars and percent, and rate of return. These tables should be presented in a similar format as the table shown at 3 - 4 of the Application (but comparing only the proposed 2013 test year with the Year 2011 actual results).

For each ratemaking area, the Settling Parties must provide the dollar and percent change in the monthly bill for the average residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4" meter (excluding any applicable surcharges).

IT IS RULED that not later than July 23, 2012, Golden State Water Company, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates, and The Utility Reform Network must file and serve the information specified in this ruling.
