**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING REQUIRING  
THE FILING OF STATUS REPORTS ON IMPLEMENTATION OF  
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND COMMENTS ON STATUS REPORTS**

Defendants, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, the Los Angeles to Pasadena Metro Blue Line Construction Authority (Construction Authority), and the City of South Pasadena (City), shall file status reports regarding the implementation of the mitigation measures addressed in the settlement agreement adopted in Decision (D.) 05-02-021, as modified in D.05-09-040, (the Settlement Agreement) with the Commission Docket Office and shall serve them on all parties by no later than the close of business on August 24, 2012. The status reports shall address the following issues:

- The status of each of the mitigation measures required by the Settlement Agreement, including actions taken to date, the remaining steps required for completion, and an approximate timetable for completion;
- A statement regarding whether Defendants have sufficient funding available to complete the remaining mitigation measures;
- Any current or anticipated problems in completing the mitigation measures; and
- Any other related issues that Construction Authority and City wish to address.

Complainant may file comments on the status reports with the Commission Docket Office and serve them on all other parties by no later than September 7, 2012. Complainant may file only one set of comments on the status reports. Individuals who are involved with the Pasadena Avenue Monterey Road Committee (PAMRC) or who are represented by PAMRC may not file separate comments.
