**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
EXTENDING TIME FOR COMMENTS AND REPLY COMMENTS**

The Assigned Commissioner's Ruling Regarding Potential Renewables Portfolio Standard Development in Imperial Valley and Evaluation of Renewable Procurement Contracts (ACR) (February 3, 2009) set dates for comments and reply comments on the proposals and issues set forth in the ACR. Comments were to be filed not later than 21 days from the date of the ACR, and reply comments were to be filed not later than seven days after the comments.

In view of the intention of Energy Division staff to hold a staff conference related to the issues in the ACR and the request of Jan Reid (made by e-mail February 4, 2009) to extend the date for reply comments, it is reasonable to extend the dates for submission of comments and reply comments by a few days.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Comments on the proposals and issues set forth in the ACR may be filed not later than February 27, 2009.
2. Reply comments may be filed not later than March 6, 2009.
