**CALIFORNIA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY WITHDRAWAL OF ITS  
PETITION FOR CLARIFICATION AND MODIFICATION OF D.10-12-016**

California-American Water Company (“California American Water”) hereby withdraws its *Petition for Clarification and Modification of D.10-12-016*, which it filed on October 14, 2011 (“Petition”), because the Petition is now moot.

In the Petition, California American Water requested that the Commission clarify whether it could go forward with the California American Water-only facilities that the Commission approved in D.10-12-016,<sup>1</sup> no matter what the status of the Regional Desalination Project. Subsequently, however, California American Water withdrew its support for the Regional Desalination Project after it became clear that the multiple obstacles facing the Project would prevent California American Water from meeting the December 2016 deadline established by the State Water Resources Control Board. California American Water is concurrently filing an application for approval of a new project, the Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project. The California American Water-only facilities are part of the Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project and California American Water addresses the treatment of these facilities in the new application.

The new application renders the Petition moot; California American Water therefore withdraws the Petition. This proceeding should remain open, however, to address recovery of any remaining costs from the Regional Desalination Project.
