**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
GRANTING MOTIONS FOR PARTY STATUS**

This ruling grants the following motions for party status previously filed in this proceeding, as noted below.

Ecology Action of Santa Cruz, Inc. is a regional nonprofit provider of innovative conservation strategies and services that address climate change, conserve natural resources, improve quality of life and contribute to a sustainable economy.

Efficiency 2.0, LLC (E2.0) is an energy efficiency software and program administration company with a presence in California. E2.0 generates verified energy savings for utility clients through innovative software tools, direct & community marketing, and reward and incentive strategies.

The Local Government Sustainable Energy Coalition is a statewide organization that advocates before California's energy and environmental regulatory agencies for the interests of local governments. Its members are leaders among local governments in energy efficiency, renewable energy, climate action planning, and related issues.

The California Energy Efficiency Industry Council (Efficiency Council) is a statewide trade association of non-utility companies that provide energy efficiency services and products in California. The Efficiency Council's stated mission is to support appropriate energy efficiency policies and programs that foster long-term economic growth, stable and reasonably priced energy infrastructures, and environmental improvement.

The City and County of San Francisco is a local governmental entity with an interest in the matters raised by this proceeding, as a representative of bundled customers, an incipient Community Choice Aggregator, and a program implementer. Accordingly, the City seeks party status in this proceeding.

IT IS RULED that each of the motions for party status, filed respectively by Ecology Action of Santa Cruz, Inc., Efficiency 2.0, LLC, Local Government Sustainable Energy Coalition, The California Energy Efficiency Industry Council, and the City and County of San Francisco are hereby granted. Each of these respective parties are granted party status in this proceeding.
