**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
ADMITTING SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS INTO THE RECORD**

The assigned Commissioner previously determined that various documents in the record of Rulemaking 11-02-019 may be relevant to our consideration of both Applicants' Safety Enhancement proposals in this proceeding. Therefore, both Applicants were directed to meet and confer with the parties to identify a proposed list of documents currently in the rulemaking's record (whether filed or in evidence) to be included in this proceeding's record, and to file a motion to introduce those documents into this proceeding. (Scoping Memo at 7-8.) San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) timely filed the motion on March 9, 2012. There has been no opposition to this motion and it is therefore granted as discussed below.

The attached list of documents from the motion is attached to this ruling as Attachment I. These documents are now received in the record of this application. No other documents from the Rulemaking, whether currently in its

record or subsequently added to its record, shall be considered part of the record of this application unless specifically introduced and received into the record either by motion and ruling, or through admission into the record at an evidentiary hearing.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. The documents listed in Attachment I to this ruling are admitted into the record for Application 11-11-002 from Rulemaking 11-02-019.
2. No other items from the record of Rulemaking 11-02-019 shall be a part of the record of this application unless specifically received into the record either by motion and ruling, or through admission into the record at an evidentiary hearing.
