ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING NOTICING WORKSHOP AND REQUESTING COMMENT ON STAFF PROPOSAL FOR SOLAR INCENTIVES FOR MULTI-FAMILY LOW INCOME HOUSING

This ruling requests comments from interested stakeholders on a proposal by Staff of the Commission's Energy Division regarding solar incentives for multi-family low-income housing. The Staff Proposal is attached to this ruling as Appendix A.

Parties are requested to file comments on the proposal, including any specific questions posed throughout the proposal or in Section 6 of the document, no later than March 26, 2008. Parties may file reply comments no later than April 4, 2008. When filing comments, parties should refer to the section numbers in the proposal document to facilitate review of the comments.

Energy Division will facilitate a workshop with interested parties to discuss its proposal on March 17, 2008. The workshop will be held in the Commission Auditorium, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., on March 17, 2008. The workshop will not be recorded and will not be part of the formal record of the proceeding, but is held for the purpose of facilitating understanding of the Staff

Proposal and generating ideas for further consideration. If parties have specific proposals or comments on the Staff Proposal attached to this ruling, they should file written comments by the dates in this ruling to ensure they are part of the Commission's formal record for decision-making.

Because the Commission realizes that there may be persons or organizations interested in this topic who are not formal parties to this proceeding, the Energy Division will accept letters with comments on the proposal from such interested persons or organizations. These informal letters from non-parties should be sent to Energy Division no later than April 4, 2008. Comments should be addressed to Melicia Charles in the Commission's Energy Division. Parties to the proceeding are reminded that their comments must be filed with the Commission's Docket Office.

Therefore, **IT IS RULED** that:

1. Parties may file comments on the Energy Division Staff Proposal attached to this ruling, no later than March 26, 2008.
2. Parties may file reply comments no later than April 4, 2008.
3. The Energy Division will hold a workshop on its proposal on March 17, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., at the Commission Auditorium, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California.
