R03-08-018 - Order Instituting Rulemaking to review policies concerning intrastate carrier access charges.

Summary: On April 9, 2007, Greg Gierczak, Executive Director, External Relations for SureWest Communications, met with Lester Wong, advisor to Pres. Peevey in San Francisco. Gierczak discussed the merits of waiting until action at the federal level addressing intercarrier compensation prior to mandating an access charge reduction for SureWest Telephone and SureWest Broadband (SureWest). Gierczak stated that the elimination of the network interconnection charge component of access rates (NIC) will significantly reduce SureWest's annual intrastate access revenues and correspondingly increase the price of basic telephone services to end users. Gierczak stated that the PD should be modified to allow URF carriers the flexibility to develop their own rate design in order to recover the loss in NIC access revenues.
