R E S O L U T I O N

Resolution G-3409. Corrects clerical errors in Resolution G-3408.

Resolution A-4661 dated March 9, 1977 authorizes the Executive Director of the Commission to sign, on behalf of the Commission, orders involving the correction of typographical and clerical errors, and other obvious, inadvertent errors and omissions in decisions and orders of the Commission.

At its meeting on June 21, 2007 the Commission adopted Resolution G-3401 which addressed Southern California Gas Company's (SoCalGas) request filed in Advice Letter 3737-G to dispose of the underlying Visual Basic computer code of the Expected Performance Based Buydown (EPBB) Calculator. The version of the resolution approved by the Commission contained inadvertent typographical and clerical errors produced when revisions were made to the initial draft of the resolution that had been issued for public comment. The Header section from pages 2-6 inadvertently labeled the Advice Letter from PG&E instead of the correct utility of SoCalGas.

The Resolution that corrected the above errors contained a typographical error. The Resolution was labeled E-3408 in the header instead of G-3408.

Under Resolution A-4661, **IT IS ORDERED** that Resolution G-3408 is corrected as set forth in the attachment to this Resolution.

This Resolution is effective today.
