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On October 14, 2008 the California Public Utilities Commission will host a public meeting to gather additional information from the public regarding the October 2007 San Diego area fires.

The public meeting will be facilitated by an Administrative Law Judge from the Commission and will be recorded by court reporters. Commissioners from the Public Utilities Commission and elected officials are expected to attend and they may make brief statements at the beginning of the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting is two fold. First, the Commission's Consumer Protection and Safety Division will give a short presentation describing the results of their investigation into the fires and an overview of their role and next steps in the process. Members of the public are invited to share their observations, experiences and other relevant information regarding the fires. The Commission is particularly interested in obtaining relevant information regarding tree trimming, line clearances, and other aspects of utility operations, from the public's perspective. This meeting is intended to assist the Commission in developing appropriate corrective measures in order to reduce the risk of fires in California.

In order to ensure that all member of the public have a chance to speak, we ask speakers to limit their statements to 3 minutes. Resolution TL-19094 - Draft Resolution Extending Authority for Vessel Common Carriers to Adjust Fares and Rates Available for Public Review and Comment

A draft resolution (TL-19094) of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD) that extends for one year the authority granted to vessel common carriers by Resolution TL-19042 and subsequent resolutions to adjust their passenger fares and freight rates without specific Commission authorization within a “zone of reasonableness” will be on the November 6, 2008, Commission meeting agenda. The draft resolution also increases the zone of reasonableness from 20% to 30% above authorized base fares and rates. The Commission may vote on this resolution at that time, or it may postpone a vote until later. When the Commission votes on Resolution TL-19094, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution.
