SUBJECT: Order authorizing Citizens Utilities Company of California to increase rates for water service in the Niles-Decoto District, Alameda County, to offset increases in charges for electric power and replenishment assessment.

WHEREAS: CITIZENS UTILITIES COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter No. 117, filed June 5, 1974, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Niles-Decoto District, Alameda County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Citizens Utilities Company of California is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 117 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be June 30, 1974.
