SUBJECT: Order authorizing Coarsegold Highlands Water System to increase rates for water service in Madera County.

WHEREAS: COARSEGOLD HIGHLANDS WATER SYSTEM, by Advice Letter No. 3, filed November 4, 1974, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in Madera County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Coarsegold Highlands Water System, is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 3 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be January 1, 1975.
