**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing Dominguez Water Corporation to increase rates for water service in Los Angeles County, to offset increases in charges for purchased water and replenishment assessment.

**WHEREAS:** DOMINGUEZ WATER CORPORATION by Advice Letter No. 71, filed June 9, 1975, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its Los Angeles County service area, and

**WHEREAS:** The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

**THE COMMISSION FINDS** that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

**IT IS ORDERED** that Dominguez Water Corporation is authorized to make effective the revised Rate Schedules Nos. 276-W and 277-W attached to Advice Letter No. 71 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be July 13, 1975.
