**SUBJECT:** Order authorizing Patterson City Water Company to increase rates for water service in Patterson City, Stanislaus County, to offset increases in purchased power expense.

**WHEREAS:** PATTERSON CITY WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 31, filed November 25, 1975, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service, and

**WHEREAS:** The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

**THE COMMISSION FINDS** that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

**IT IS ORDERED** that Patterson City Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate Schedule No. 1 attached to Advice Letter No. 31 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be January 4, 1976.
