SUBJECT: Order authorizing Macdoel Water Works to revise and modify certain of its present rules for water service in Siskiyou County.

WHEREAS: MACDOEL WATER WORKS, by Advice Letter No. 5, filed September 25, 1975, requests authority to change certain of its rules governing water service which will result in technical increases in Rule No. 7, Deposits, and in Rule No. 11, Discontinuance and Restoration of Service, and

WHEREAS: These changes consist of changing the required deposit to establish credit from \$2.50 for monthly bills to twice the periodic monthly bill, and increasing the reconnection charge from \$1 to \$10 and for other than regular working hours to \$15, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS that these changes in the rules are justified and reasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Macdoel Water Works be authorized to make the necessary changes in its filed rules as transmitted with Advice Letter No. 5.
