SUBJECT: Order authorizing Dominguez Water Corporation to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement with Southern California Edison Company, Los Angeles County.

WHEREAS: DOMINGUEZ WATER CORPORATION, by Advice Letter No. 65 filed November 14, 1973, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code and Section X-A of General Order No. 96-A to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement with Southern California Edison Company for the installation of the necessary equipment to meet the fire flow requirements imposed upon it by the fire protection authority, and

WHEREAS: The utility has sufficient facilities already within the area to meet the commercial needs of Edison but not sufficient to meet the fire flow requirements, and

WHEREAS: Southern California Edison Company will advance the estimated cost of the facilities of \$160,740.54, subject to adjustment to actual costs but not subject to refund in order to meet the fire flow requirements.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the terms and conditions of the agreement will not be adverse to the public interest and are justified.

IT IS ORDERED that Dominguez Water Corporation is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement referred to above and filed with Advice Letter No. 65.
