SUBJECT: Order authorizing Bakman Water Company to increase rates for water service in Fresno County.

WHEREAS: Bakman Water Company, by Advice Letter No. 24, filed December 18, 1974 requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in Fresno County, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable,

IT IS ORDERED that Bakman Water Company, is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedules attached to Advice Letter No. 24 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedules for service. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall be February 1, 1975.
