SUBJECT: Order authorizing Southwest Water Company to increase rates for water service in the La Mirada District, Los Angeles and Orange Counties, to offset increases in charges for purchased water and power, ad valorem taxes, and wages and employee benefits.

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST WATER COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 69, filed July 14, 1976, requests authority under General Order No. 96-A, Section VI, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service in its La Mirada District, and

WHEREAS: The Commission is of the opinion, after investigation by its staff, that the requested rate increase is reasonable,

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present rates are, for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that Southwest Water Company is authorized to make effective the revised rate schedule attached to Advice Letter No. 69 and on the effective date herein to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service. The effective date of the revised rate schedule shall be August 15, 1976. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
