8. An ICBA surcharge of \$0.0232 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2024-A, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-007.
9. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.0612 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 24 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A.
