**ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER'S RULING REVISING THE SCHEDULE
FOR PHASE 4 OF THE LOW-INCOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY
STANDARDIZATION PROJECT**

This ruling approves a revised schedule for Phase 4 of the Low Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) Standardization Project, as proposed by the joint utilities. The joint utilities are: Pacific Gas and Electric Company,

Southern California Edison Company, Southern California Gas Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company.

On January 28, 2003, I issued a ruling approving an augmentation of the budget for Phase 4 of the Low Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) Standardization Project and additions to the Phase 4 work plan, as proposed by the joint utilities. Attached to that ruling was a revised schedule for completing Phase 4, which was presented under Section IV of Attachment 1 to that ruling.

At my request, the Standardization Project Team had submitted a revised schedule to the Energy Division that included completion dates for tasks 13-16.1 Energy Division inadvertently submitted an outdated version of the schedule to me, which then was attached to my former ruling. After my ruling issued on January 28th, Energy Division realized its error and submitted the correct revised schedule to me.

Accordingly, the correct revised schedule for Phase 4, as presented in Attachment 1, is adopted.
