Order Instituting Rulemaking to Implement the California Renewables Portfolio Standard Program.

**Summary:** On June 13, 2005, Eric Eisenman, Manager, Regulatory Relations, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), met with Aaron Johnson, advisor to Cmmr. Grueneich, in San Francisco. Also present were Brian Prusnek, advisor to Cmmr. Kennedy, Ken Lewis, Brian Schumacher, Robert Elliott, and Tom Flynn (via telephone), for the Energy Division, and Hal La Flash, Director, Gas & Electric Supply, Kevin Dasso, Senior Director, Electric T&D Engineering, and David Kraska, Attorney, Law Department, for PG&E. Written materials (attached to the notice) were used. La Flash explained that the Independent System Operator has identified some operating issues that need to be considered for wind generation and intends to study how to improve operations with wind generators. La Flash stated that PG&E recommends that the Commission establish a schedule that includes recognition of the need to tie the development of transmission from the Tehachapi area to specific external events and changes in the marketplace, including results from competitive solicitations. La Flash added that the wind resources competitiveness must be considered in a 'least-cost, best-fit' process. Dasso discussed several conceptual transmission alternatives for Tehachapi.
