RESOLUTION NO. W-4605

June 15, 2006

**R E S O L U T I O N**

**(RES. W-4605), WATERTEK, INC., METROPOLITAN DISTRICT (METROPOLITAN). ORDER AUTHORIZING AN INTERIM GENERAL RATE INCREASE SUBJECT TO REFUND, PRODUCING AN INCREASE IN GROSS ANNUAL REVENUES OF \$2,248 OR 26.9%.**

---

**SUMMARY**

By Draft Advice Letter accepted on May 15, 2006, Watertek's Metropolitan District requested an increase in rates to produce an increase in annual revenue of \$10,008, or 137% for test year 2006. To provide Metropolitan with sufficient income to pay operating expenses pending the processing of the utility's general rate case (GRC), this resolution grants Metropolitan an interim general rate increase in gross annual revenues of \$2,248 or 26.9%. This interim increase is subject to refund upon the final resolution of Metropolitan's GRC request.

**BACKGROUND**

Metropolitan is a District of Watertek, a Class D water utility and serves approximately 29 customers located approximately two miles west of Fresno in Fresno County.

Metropolitan requested authority under Section VI of General Order 96 and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates for water service to produce additional revenues of \$10,008 or 137% in test year 2006. Metropolitan's request shows 2006 gross revenues of \$7,323 at present rates increasing to \$17,331 at proposed rates to produce a rate of return on rate base of 15.6%.

Metropolitan's present rates became effective January 3, 2006, pursuant to Decision (D.) 92-03-093, which authorized a Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase. The last general rate increase was approved on April 10, 1991, by Res. W-3555 which granted an increase of \$4,432 or 123.1% with a zero rate of return on rate base.

**NOTICE**

A draft notice regarding the general rate increase was mailed to the utility on May 15, 2006. A notice of the full increase request will be mailed to the customers on May 20, 2006. This Resolution is for an Interim General Rate Increase subject to refund.

**PROTESTS**

This is an uncontested matter subject to the public notice comment exclusion provided in the Public Utilities Code Section 311 (g) (3).

**DISCUSSION**

The Service Guarantee Plan for Small Water Companies (Standard Practice U-9-SM) as augmented by Res. No.W-4540 dated June 16, 2005, Ordering Paragraph 3, allows an interim rate increase for small water companies operating at a loss on a cash-flow basis. The interim rate increase provides the utility with sufficient income to cover its operating expenses. It is subject to refund pending the final resolution of Metropolitan's general rate increase request.

Metropolitan is currently operating at a loss. The rate increase request was based on financial information for the period from January through December 2005. After an analysis of these records, the Utility Audit, Finance, and Compliance Branch calculates that Metropolitan should be allowed an interim increase of \$2,248 in order for the utility to meet its cash-flow requirements.

**COMMENTS**

**FINDINGS**

1. The interim rates recommended by the Water Division (Appendix A) are reasonable and should be adopted.
2. The rate increase authorized in this resolution is subject to refund pending the completion of the staff investigation of Watertek's Metropolitan District general rate increase request.
3. This is an uncontested matter subject to the public notice comment exclusion provided in the Public Utilities Code Section 311(g) (3).

**THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Watertek, Inc. is authorized to file an advice letter for its Metropolitan District incorporating the rates contained in Schedules Nos. 1-MP, General Metered Service, and 2-MP, Residential Flat Rate Service, attached to this resolution as Appendix A, and to concurrently cancel Schedules Nos. 1-MP and 2-MP. Its filing shall comply with General Order 96-A. The effective date of the revised rate schedules shall not be earlier than five days after the date of its filing.
