NOTICE OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION RECORDS

Draft Resolution L-368 authorizes disclosure of records related to the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Utilities Safety and Reliability Branch’s investigation of an electrical incident that occurred on February 17, 2005 on Telegraph Canyon Road near SDG&E Substation in Chula Vista, San Diego County.

Draft Resolution L-368 will be on the agenda at the Commission’s October 2, 2008, meeting. The Commission may then vote on the resolution or it may postpone a vote until later. The Commission may adopt all or part of L-368, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution.
