**COMMENTS OF DEMAND RESPONSE AGGREGATORS
ON THE PROPOSED DECISION OF ALJ HECHT**

EnerNOC, Inc. (EnerNOC), EnergyConnect, Inc. (EnergyConnect), Energy Curtailment Specialists (ECS), and Comverge, Inc. (Comverge) (Demand Response (DR) Aggregators) respectfully submit these Comments on the Proposed Decision of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Hecht Granting in Part the Petition for Modification by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) of Decision (D.) 09-08-027 (“Petition for Modification”). The Proposed Decision was mailed on November 15, 2010. These Comments are timely filed and served pursuant to Article 14 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure and the instructions accompanying the Proposed Decision.

**I.
WITH MODIFICATIONS TO REFLECT THE CURRENT STATUS OF PDR,
THE PROPOSED DECISION SHOULD BE ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION.**

The DR Aggregators commend ALJ Hecht for issuing a Proposed Decision that confirms the Commission’s policy preference for procurement of cost-effective energy efficiency and demand response over other electric resources. In addition, EnerNOC and EnergyConnect

support the Proposed Decision’s conclusion that PG&E demonstrated that “the additional [DR] commitment” for 2011 represented by the modifications in its Petition for Modification is “cost-effective.”¹ The Proposed Decision also confirms the propriety of PG&E modifying these existing agreements to conform to the Commission’s current baseline methodology and multiple program participation rules.² The requested contract modifications will increase the amount of cost-effective DR available to PG&E, provide greater opportunity for PG&E’s customers to participate in DR, and bring the contracts into closer conformance with the Commission’s current policies on baselines and dual participation.³

Although the DR Aggregators continue to support PG&E’s request to hold a competitive solicitation, the Proposed Decision’s logic in rejecting that request is understandable. Namely, the Proposed Decision necessarily takes into account the time required (“a year or more”) to “make the solicitation, evaluate bids, negotiate contracts, and obtain Commission approval of the contracts as proposed by PG&E” and the likely upcoming and intervening decisions that would impact such a solicitation.⁴ In addition, the Proposed Decision provides an opportunity for PG&E to request that the existing contracts be extended for 2012:

“If circumstances warrant and new aggregator contracts are not available in 2012, PG&E may request that its existing contracts be extended to continue for that year.”⁵

DR Aggregators strongly support the Proposed Decision with modifications to reflect the current status of Proxy Demand Resource (PDR), as described below. With those changes, the DR Aggregators ask that the Commission adopt the Proposed Decision.

II.
**THE PROPOSED DECISION’S STATEMENTS REGARDING
PROXY DEMAND RESPONSE SHOULD BE CORRECTED.**

The DR Aggregators find the Proposed Decision well-reasoned. However, before it is adopted by the Commission, the Proposed Decision should be corrected to reflect the current status of California Independent System Operator’s (CAISO’s) Proxy Demand Resource (PDR) as follows:

A. The Proposed Decision makes the following two statements about PDR:

(1) “PDR has not been implemented, and likely will be implemented sometime in 2011.”⁶

(2) “CAISO’s PDR product is not yet in operation.”⁷

However, the CAISO fully implemented PDR on August 10, 2010. What has not been decided are the Commission’s rules for how investor-owned utilities and DR providers will participate in PDR.

Therefore, these statements should be changed to read:

(1) “PDR ~~has not been~~ **was** implemented on August 10, 2010, ~~and likely will be implemented sometime in 2011.~~”

(2) CAISO’s PDR product is ~~not yet~~ in operation.”

B. The Proposed Decision’s Finding of Fact 15 states: “CAISO’s PDR product is not yet available through CAISO markets.”⁸ For the reasons stated in Section A. above, this finding should be deleted in its entirety as follows:

~~“15. CAISO’s PDR product is not yet available through CAISO markets.”~~

C. The Proposed Decision’s Finding of Fact 20 must also be modified to reflect the correct status of the CAISO’s PDR. Accordingly, the DR Aggregators propose the following modification of Finding of Fact 20:

~~“20. Neither the PDR rules nor~~ The Commission’s rules for Direct Participation of DRPs in CAISO markets have not yet been finalized.”

III. CONCLUSION

With the requested modifications to reflect the current status of PDR, the DR Aggregators strongly recommend that the Commission issue the Proposed Decision as written. The contract amendments, especially in the absence of a solicitation, will provide an increased commitment of cost-effective DR resources in a manner that furthers, and is consistent with, current Commission policy.
