Specifically, ACWA’s comments will focus on the Greater Focus on Water-Energy Nexus Programs requested in the Assigned Commissioner’s Ruling And Scoping Memo Regarding 2013-2014 Bridge Portfolio And Post-Bridge Planning, Phase IV on October 25, 2011.
