Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure the Local Government Sustainable Energy Coalition ("LGSEC") respectfully requests that the Commission Shorten the time for responding to the Motion to Shorten Time to Respond to LGSEC's Motion to Establish and Fund Local Government Regional Energy Networks ("Regional Energy Network Motion").

The Commission has indicated that a Proposed Decision providing guidance for the 2013-2014 transition period will be issued in the first quarter 2012.¹ The Regional Energy Network Motion requests the Commission to issue a ruling as soon as possible directing California's Investor-Owned Utilities to cooperate with LGSEC and fund Regional Energy Networks. By this Motion, the LGSEC proposes shortening the deadline to 10 days, making responses due on March 5, 2012. There will be no prejudice to any of the parties to this proceeding if time for responding to the Regional Energy Network Motion is shortened.
