TO: PARTIES TO DRAFT RESOLUTION EGPB-10

Enclosed is Draft Resolution EGPB-10 of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division addressing the Final Report on the Audit of the Encina Power Plant. It will be on the agenda at the January 13, 2011 Commission meeting. The Commission may then vote on this Resolution or it may postpone a vote until later.

When the Commission votes on a Draft Resolution, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend, modify or set it aside and prepare a different Resolution. Only when the Commission acts does the Resolution become binding on the parties.

You may file comments on this Resolution by Monday, January 3, 2011, with reply comments sent no later than Monday, January 10, 2011. Comments shall be limited to five pages in length plus a subject index listing the recommended changes to the Draft Resolution, a table of authorities and an appendix setting forth the proposed findings and ordering paragraphs. It shall focus on factual, legal or technical errors in the proposed Draft Resolution. Comments that merely reargue positions taken in the advice letter or protests will be accorded no weight and are not to be submitted.

Please serve your comments by mail or electronically on the entire service list attached to the Draft Resolution. Late submitted comments or reply comments will not be considered.
