**TO PARTIES OF RECORD IN DRAFT RESOLUTION EGPB-12**

This is draft Resolution EGPB-12 of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division. It will be on the May 26, 2011, Commission Meeting agenda. The Commission may act then, or it may postpone action until later.

The draft Resolution approves the joint request from AES Huntington Beach, LLC and Edison Mission Huntington Beach, LLC to permanently retire Huntington Beach Units 3 and 4 No earlier than November 1, 2012.

When the Commission acts on the Resolution, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare its own decision. Only when the commission acts does the resolution become binding on the parties.

Parties may file comments on the Resolution as provided in Article 14 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), accessible on the Commission's website at [www.cpuc.ca.gov](http://www.cpuc.ca.gov). Pursuant to Rule 14.3, opening comments shall not exceed 15 pages. Late-submitted comments or reply comments will not be considered.
